Declaration of Intent: No Gift Policy

Mahasarakham Business School, Mahasarakham University, is committed to fostering values of integrity, ethics, and moral awareness in all operations, with honesty and transparency at the core. This commitment aligns with the principles of good governance and aims to prevent risks of corruption and misconduct among executives and staff within the School. The objective is to drive the organization toward achieving its goals efficiently, effectively, and with maximum benefit, while promoting transparency and eliminating corruption and conflicts of interest in the execution of official duties. In addition, the policy serves to instill awareness, cultivate an organizational culture of integrity, and uphold ethical conduct without seeking personal gain. As such, Mahasarakham Business School has established a No Gift Policy, under which all personnel are prohibited from accepting any form of gifts or gratuities in connection with the performance of their duties. The policy is to be implemented under the following guidelines:

1. Personnel of Mahasarakham Business School shall not accept any type of gifts or gratuities, whether before or after the performance of duties, as such acceptance may lead to corruption or misconduct both in the present and future;
2. Personnel of Mahasarakham Business School shall not seek or solicit gifts, gratuities, or any form of personal benefit;
3. Expressions of congratulations, good wishes, or greetings from or to external individuals should be made through signing greeting cards, guest books, or by using social media platforms, instead of offering physical gifts; and
4. Personnel of Mahasarakham Business School have a responsibility to clearly inform external parties about this policy.
